

The new building will be 2.5 times larger than the existing and will incorporate 12 parking spaces on site. The aim is to make the practice as environmentally friendly as possible, including sustainable building materials such as plantation timber, rammed earth, straw bale and planted rooves. Other technologies will include natural heating and cooling, solar power, water recycling, non toxic finishes and efficient lighting.

Lotus are hoping to work with one of the local schools in creating a sustainability model that can be observed and researched over the next 25 years, in what is becoming a very important topic in our future lives. This will be a very exciting project and the first of its kind in the village and they are hoping to inspire the community to work towards a more sustainable future.




