# Is Your Dog "Dominant"?!

It's really quite frightening what people do. iust because they saw it on TV. Do we really believe that dogs are trying to take over our world and dominate the human race? Is Fluffy really a big bad wolf plotting to overthrow the family? In a word, NO.

Last week, in my vet clinic, I was "told" by an ageing Cesar Millan fan, that it was my ault my Airedale Terrier didn't like the clinic cat! And, if I showed calm "dominance", my dog might like the cat. Sorry, not going to take that chance!

In the past few weeks I have had several calls from distressed dog owners who have tried be a wolf and "dominate" their dogs, holding them on the ground by the throat, just like the trainer on TV. All were bitten. Quote By Dr Sophia Yin From Veterinary Forum Clinical Update March 2009:

"This treatment is based on an incorrect understanding of what happens in the wild.

For decades trainers have assumed that higher ranked wolves pin lower ranked ones in this alpha roll as a powerplay. In reality, it's not the higher ranked wolf that forces the lower one down, rather the lower ranked one offers this ritualistic posture as a sign of deference the way one might bow or kneel before royalty. Consequently a more appropriate term for this posture would be a submissive roll (Yin 2009)." http://www.askdryin.com/ dominance.php


