

St Leonard's College Students Take a World View of the Environment

Year 9 students at St Leonard's College are involved in an experiential learning program that involves a series of off-campus activities. Students progress through the three domains of the program - Community Service, Urban Exploration and Environmental Sustainability. They have a "CUE Day Out" every second Wednesday over a period of approximately ten weeks for each domain and five 45 minute periods in the classroom for reflection and discussion. The program culminates in the "Big Experience" in term four which draws all the elements of the program into an overseas or Australian-based three week experience.

The students' education goes beyond the classroom and provides many stimulating opportunities. The program offers challenges to students and thereby is a vehicle for their personal development. The curriculum followed in the classroom in English, Science and other subjects provides links and further opportunities to develop the themes and concepts investigated in each of the domains of the CUE program.



In term 4 students take part in the 'Big Experience' and travel to overseas destinations such as China, Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia and Fiji, to learn about community, urban and environmental issues and be powerful and empowering for all involved. Each student's unique experience will have parallels to life itself in facing challenges, learning to live with others, to be responsible, independent and caring citizens of the world.

"The CUE program is very different from other subjects," says teacher and program coordinator Tim Barlow. "We don't do our learning in the classroom, we do our learning in the world."
